Who is your favorite character and why?

How are the kids in the story like you or not like you?

Which was your favorite room in the LIFE IS SWEET candy factory? (The Cocoa Room, Mashmallow Room, Taffy Room, Tropical Room, etc.) Is there a room you wish it had?

If you could create your own candy, what would it be called? What ingredients would you use?

Would you want to live in a candy factory? Why or why not?

What did you think the secret ingredient was going to be at the end of the book? Why is it so important?

Why does Philip have to win the contest? If you were in Logan, Daisy, or Miles's shoes, would you work with Phillip to help him win?

Has there been a time when your friends or family helped you to succeed?
